

AAP 2019 Annual Meeting Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes
OFFICIAL RULES
NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The AAP 2019 Annual Meeting Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes (the "Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes") is open only to individuals who are: (a) legal residents of one of the 50 United States; (b) 18 years of age or older, and, (c) current AAP members. Immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and household members of AAP members are not eligible. Employees of the AAP, Exhibitors and their employees, as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and household members of each such individual are not eligible. The Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law.
2. **SPONSOR:** The Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes is sponsored by the American Academy of Periodontology (the "Sponsor"), 737 N. Michigan Avenue, Suite 800, Chicago, IL 60611.
3. **PROMOTION PERIOD:** The entry period for the prize drawing for the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes is 12:01 a.m. Central Time on Wednesday, October 31, 2018, through 11:59 p.m. Central Time on Saturday, March 29, 2019 ("Promotion Period").
4. **HOW TO ENTER:** The AAP will automatically enter all eligible individuals who during the Promotion Period: Successfully register for the AAP's 2019 Annual Meeting or submit an entry via email to bridget@perio.org. Eligible individuals must complete their registration, or submit an email entry, no later than 11:59 p.m. Central Time, Saturday, March 29, 2019, to be added to the drawing.
5. **PRIZES:** One entrant will be selected to receive two tickets to a Chicago Trolley & Double Decker Tour; and one entrant will be selected to receive two tickets to a river cruise from Chicago's First Lady Cruise for a total of two winners. The Chicago Trolley & Double Decker Tour tickets have an approximate value of \$98; the river cruise from Chicago's First Lady Cruise tickets have an approximate value of \$94. No cash or other substitution is allowed except by the Sponsor who may substitute a prize (or component thereof) with another prize (or component thereof) of equal or greater value if any advertised prize becomes unavailable, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. If applicable, prizes will be reported as income to the winner and the winner will be responsible for payment and reporting of all applicable taxes associated with the receipt of a prize. Limit of one prize per individual.
6. **PRIZE DRAWINGS:** The drawing for the prizes will take place by 5 p.m. Central Time, Friday, April 5, 2019, after the close of the Promotion Period. Sponsor will

select the name of the potential winner in a random drawing of all entries received by the close of the Promotion Period. Winner does not need to be present to win. Sponsor will notify the potential winner by email at the address provided on the Annual Meeting registration form and/or by the telephone number provided on the Annual Meeting registration form. If no response is received from the potential winner within five business days by 4:45 p.m. CT, the next individual will be selected at random until a potential winner is selected. The manner and timing of notification may be modified as the Sponsor deems appropriate in its sole and absolute discretion.

7. **ODDS:** The odds of being selected for each prize depend on the number of eligible entries received.
8. **REQUIREMENTS:** If it is determined by Sponsor, in its sole and absolute discretion, that the potential winner is not eligible to participate or receive a prize in accordance with these Official Rules, an alternate entrant shall be selected in his/her place in a random drawing of all entries received. Each winner is responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes on the value of the prize awarded.
9. **AGREEMENT WITH OFFICIAL RULES:** Participation in the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of Sponsor, which are final and binding. The prize award is contingent upon the potential winner's fulfillment of all requirements set forth in these Official Rules.
10. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:** In the event that the operation of Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to, fraud, virus, or other technical problems, Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either: (a) suspend the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes to address the impairment and then resume the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules; or (b) award the prizes at random from among the eligible entries received up to the time of the impairment.

Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the operation of the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

11. **RELEASE AND LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:** By participating in the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes, entrants agree to release and hold harmless Sponsor, its officers, trustees, employees, agents, contractors, and assigns (the "Released Parties"), from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes or receipt or use of any prize, including, but not limited to: (a) unauthorized human intervention in the

Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes; (b) printing errors; (c) errors in the administration of the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes or the processing of entries; or (d) injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes or receipt of any prize. Entrant further agrees that in any cause of action, the Released Parties' liability will be limited to the cost of entering and participating in the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes, and in no event shall the Released Parties be liable for attorney's fees. Entrant waives the right to claim any damages whatsoever, including, but not limited to, punitive, consequential, direct, or indirect damages.

12. **DISPUTES:** Except where prohibited, entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in the State of Illinois. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation, and enforceability of these Official Rules, entrant's rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of Sponsor in connection with the Early-Bird Registration Sweepstakes, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Illinois, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of the State of Illinois or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Illinois.
